**PUBLICATIONS (KRISTIAN THORBORG):**

Kristian Thorborg has published 135 articles in the form of 105 peer-reviewed publications and 30 non-peer reviewed publications. Furthermore, Kristian has published individual 24 book chapters and 1 book. Kristian Thorborg is the first author on 28 peer-reviewed publications and the last author on 24 peer-reviewed publications and has published more than >100 abstracts: presented more than >50 oral presentations and >10 posters at national and international scientific conference proceedings since 2008. Kristian Thorborg is first author on 26 non-peer-reviewed publications. Kristian Thorborg h-index is of 27 since 2012, with more than 2000 citations. More than 10 of Kristian Thorborg's peer-reviewed publications have an Altmetric score ("Who's talking about your research score") above 100, and Kristian Thorborg have been part of seven articles that have been chosen as Editor's Choice in BJSM which grants free open access by the journal.
